THE VALUE OF THE MEXICO-ITALY RELATIONSHIP



1. "Mexico is Italy's strategic partner" (MAECI) and "priority market for italian exports" (SACE)

- a. 15th world economy by GDP; 2nd Economy in Latin America; 11th exporter in the world and 1st in Latin America (WTO, 2020); 9th most attractive country in the world for foreign direct investment (UNCTAD), 7th world tourist destination in the world (OMT)
- b. Mexico is Italy's 2nd trading partner in the Americas, only after the USA.
- c. Italy is Mexico's 3rd. trading partner in EU countries and 12nd in the world.
- d. Bilateral foreign direct investment: Italian investments exceeded 9 billion euros in 2021 (€7 billion in 2020), while Mexican investments reached around 2 billion euros
- e. About 1,800 italian companies are established in Mexico. Currently about 60 Mexican companies operate in Mexico.

2. The Mexican economy offers various business, exchange and investment opportunities for Italy:

- a. Global logistics platform with **preferential access in 50 countries (60% of world GDP)** thanks to 14 Free Trade Agreements in America (T-MEC, Pacific Alliance), Europe (TLCUEM) and Asia-Pacific (APEC, TPP)
 - b. Ranked with 65% Investment Opportunity Index and with 60%b Export Opportunity Index (SACE).
- c. Consolidated reputation as a **global leader in sectors such as automotive, aeronautics, electronics and agroindustrial**, with significant advantage of **value chains, productive integration** and foreign trade.
