



- 92 tons of paper
- 350 kgs of walnuts and hazelnuts
- 200 silk umbrellas
- 2 vertical pianos
- Mexico → Italy:
- 1,514 tons of cotton
- 5,100 cubic meters of wood













The composition of today's trade








FDI's and Italiancontrolled enterprises in Mexico


A first episode of Italian entrepreneurship in Mexico, before the countries were born

Giovanni Paoli (later known as Juan Pablos) was born in Lombardy in the first decade of the 16° century, and later moved to Mexico.

There, he set up a company and became the (supposedly) first printer of the New World.
